Return to Revised Phase Two*

Occupancy limits

Up to 25% occupancy with social distancing and masks mandated:

- Sporting events

Up to 50% occupancy with social distancing and masks mandated:

- Gyms and fitness centers
- Restaurants, coffee shops and cafes
- Casinos and video poker
- Non-essential retail

Up to 75% occupancy with social distancing and masks mandated:

- Churches and places of worship

**High-risk individuals are encouraged to stay home in Phase 2*

Return to Revised Phase Two*

Bar limitations for parishes with more COVID spread

- **Bars in parishes with greater than 5% positivity:** Must close to indoor consumption, can allow outdoor seating up to 50 people, seated and spaced out and masks mandated.
- **Bars in parishes with 5% or below positivity:** Can allow indoor consumption up to 25% occupancy seated and spaced out; outdoor consumption encouraged and masks mandated.

Reduction in gathering sizes at Event Centers:

- Indoors, limited to 25% occupancy, masks required, up to 75 people
- Outdoors, limited to 25% occupancy, masks required, up to 150 people, where social distancing is not possible

- Individuals 65 years old or older
- Long-term care facility residents
- Vulnerable individuals: immunocompromised
OR one or more of the following health
conditions *with poor control*:
 - High blood pressure
 - Diabetes
 - Obesity
 - Chronic kidney disease
 - Heart disease
